

Clematis: Their Seasons of Bloom

- 1) Evergreen species, blooming very early:
winter & spring: *cirrhosa* and cultivars
winter: *nапaulensis* (summer dormant)
early spring: *armandii* and cultivars
New Zealand species and hybrids
- 2) Deciduous species: blooming on old wood starting in March and April:
C. alpina, koreana var. carunculosa, columbiana, japonica, koreana, macropetala, montana & its cultivars
- 3) Large-flowered hybrids that bloom starting in late April and May on last year's growth, for example:
all double LFHs
